No Class: If you are going to be missing class please let Miss Aimee know by letting her know the week before or by texting (if sick). On our end, if we are canceled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances, we will post on social media. We try to text all our parents but sometimes it isn't possible.

Water: We ask that our students **ONLY BRING WATER to class**.

Tuition: Tuition is due the first class of each month. Any payment not made by the 10th of the month will be charged a 10% late fee for every week it is late. Costumes and competition fees must also be paid by the date listed on your statement or they will be charged a 10% late fee for each week they are late.

Father (Special Guy)-Daughter Dance: Our annual Father (special guy)/Daughter dance will be held at the Seymour Congregational Church on Friday, December 13th. Paperwork has already come out for this. If you did not receive it, paperwork is on the waiting room table.

Recital Costumes: Fees for recital costumes are on your monthly statement. Costumes must be paid in full by Christmas break (As they are ordered during that time). You may pay for these as needed, in full or in partial payments. Please make sure each payment is marked clearly as "Costumes".

Christmas show: Our Christmas Show will be held at the Strand Theater in Seymour. Start time is 6:30. All dancers should arrive between 6:00 and 6:15. It is a very small venue so tickets will be limited to TWO. If you have more than one child performing you have the option to purchase THREE. All others will be put on a waitlist for extras. This is a first come, first serve basis. We will let you know about your waitlist tickets next week (December 8th). You will receive a text if we have the extra tickets for you. Payment will be due via venmo immediately or via cash/check by your next class or the tickets will go to the next in line. All tickets will be handed out the week of the 8th.

Dancers are encouraged to wear a holiday theme outfit for the holiday show, red or green for Christmas or white and blue for Hanukkah. If you do not have a holiday theme, please wear a leotard and tights and the correct shoes. Hair should be back off face in a ponytail, braid or bun. Makeup is encouraged because of the stage lights.

A reminder that at the show photos and videos are allowed but we ask that you not use sound when posting on social media and that you are respectful of other kids in the class as there are some children who cannot be posted online.

Pie Sales: The dates are incorrect on some of the pie sale forms. Orders are due back to the studio on Wednesday, December 3rd and all pies/cookies/cakes must be picked up in person on Tuesday, December 16th. This fundraiser goes directly to your own account and can be applied to recital costumes, competition fees and tuition.

Important information: We are having issues with people not reading the newsletters or checking social media. People are missing important dates due to this. There is always a newsletter hanging on the bulletin board in the waiting room and extras left on the waiting room table if yours is missing. A newsletter is always attached to the monthly statement and a copy can always be found on our website.
